1. The thesis shall be submitted to APD in electronic form in PDF file. While adding the file, its type shall be specified as **THESIS.** The prepared PDF document cannot be password-protected.

The structure of the file name shall be as following: a 2-digit abbreviation of the unit code, dash, then L (in the case of Bachelor's theses), I (in the case of Engineer's theses), or M (in the case of Master's theses), dash, abbreviation of the field of study, dash, student number, file extension ".pdf" (in lower case).

Examples:

10-L-INF-111111.pdf – Bachelor's thesis in IT 10-I-INF-222222.pdf – Engineer's thesis in IT, 12-M-ARCH-333333.pdf – Master's thesis in archeology.

2. If other elements, such as source codes of computer programmes, documentation of artistic works, etc. are attached, you should submit them to APD in a separate file compressed to zip and specify the type as **OTHER.**
