The competition is open to persons who meet the conditions set out in Article 113 of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on higher education and science (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1668) and the following qualification criteria:

1. Possession of a Master's degree in history.
2. Possession of a doctoral degree in the humanities in the discipline of history.
3. Early-career researcher (up to 7 years after earning a Ph.D.).
4. Scientific achievements in the field of History of Middle Ages, History of Towns.
5. Experience in the field of: research in medieval history and comparative studies; proven experience in securing external funding, demonstrated by concrete results; proven experience in international collaboration, including at least a one-month internship at a reputable foreign research institution.
6. Documented scientific achievements in the Polish and international arena: articles published in Polish and in the conference languages
7. Fluency in Polish, both written and spoken.
8. Very good command of English, knowledge of Latin.

4. Activities in the field of international cooperation.
5. Participation in research projects and publishing activities organized within the Faculty of Historical Sciences at Nicolaus Copernicus University.

Please be informed that the person selected through the competition will be obliged to submit a certificate from the National Criminal Register with regard to offences specified in Chapters 19 and 25 of the Penal Code (including offences against sexual freedom and morality), in Article 189a and Article 207 of the Penal Code and in the Act on Counteracting Drug Addiction of 29 July 2005 (Journal of Laws of 2023, item 1939 and of 2022, item 2600), or for the corresponding offences defined in foreign law.
