The competition is open to persons who meet the conditions set out in Article 113 of the Act of 20 July 2018 - Law on higher education and science (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1668) and the following qualification criteria:

a) a Master's degree in journalism and social communication, in sociology, or a Master's degree in sociology

b) the area of professional competences including: an area of professional competence covering in particular:

- the work of a journalist, reporter and reporter in the field, including obtaining materials, conducting interviews and preparing news, journalistic and reportage texts

- planning, editing and supervising materials published in the press and digital media, as well as managing editorial teams - journalist's workshop in traditional media, especially in the local and regional press, including reportage, journalism and text editing
 - journalist workshop in new media: news portals, CMS, SEO, content analytics, social media, AI tools and multimedia content
 - competences in the field of social communication, media sociology, journalistic ethics, public communication, information security and counteracting disinformation
 - organizational and expert experience: managing editorial offices, mentoring journalists, social and educational projects, participation in academic debates and conferences
- c) teaching and educational practice, including journalism workshops, individual consultations, mentoring and developing media competences of young people and young journalists
- d) fluent knowledge of Polish and English in spoken and written language

Terms of employment:

Full-time employment contract for the position of Assistant Lecturer (Teaching Assistant) at the Faculty of Philosophy and Social Sciences, NCU, within the Institute of Information and Communication Research, Department of Communication, Media and Journalism, for a period of 2 years with the possibility of extension.
